
MARK 10:33-34

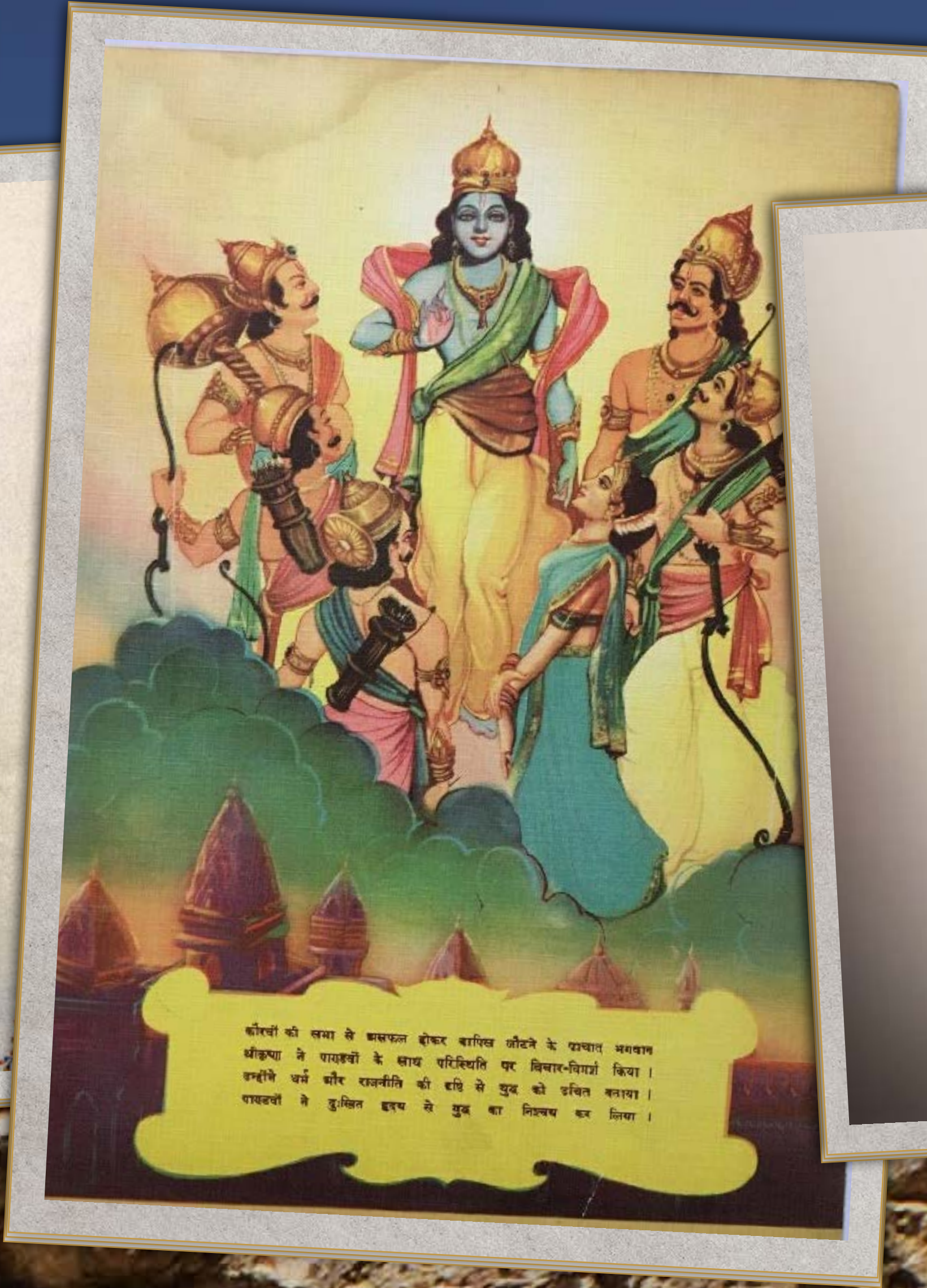
